7:25 am to 2.00 pm

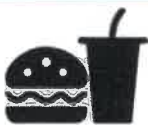
Students must be in school by 7:15 am for the morning assembly

TIPS TO PARENTS

While there can be a lot to take in all at once, children are very adaptable. They usually settle quickly into their new environment.

Give your child some time to adjust to the school environment. Listen to their problems with an open mind. Help your children discover ways to overcome problems. Teachers are available should you require further advice.

DRESS CODE / SCHOOL UNIFORM

As per any new school, we hope to involve our stakeholders in the forging of the identity of the school, which includes the design of the school uniform. As such, for the time being, students are advised to follow the following dress code.

Boys

Long pants (Dark color)
Plain Shirt (Short Sleeves – Any color)
Black Sports Shoes with long white

Girls

Plain Baju Kurung (any color) OR Shirt with Long sleeves and Skirt (below the knees)
Black Sports shoes with long white socks

Muslim girl students are encouraged to put on the Hijab.

WHAT TO PACK FOR THE FIRST DAY OF SCHOOL



1. Stationeries such as small exercise book (brown color) duly labelled
2. Labelling of your child stationeries including erasers and pencils. Students bringing pencils to class comes the responsibility of sharpening their own pencils and colour pencils. This is a necessary skill for Primary 1 students as they do a lot of writing and colouring in class.
3. Water bottle
4. Extra clothes (for any untoward circumstances).

Note: It is also important to teach your child to pack his own school bag, keep his books, stationery and water bottle in his bag by him/herself. It is not uncommon to find students' books, pencil cases, water bottles being left behind under their desks after dismissal. In their hurry to go home, they have forgotten to keep these stuff into their school bag.

STUDENTS' DISCIPLINE

We are passionate about providing a safe and conducive environment for your child to excel. We hope to achieve this through maintaining good discipline. Students will be taught to practice good manners and show consideration towards their teachers and friends.

The first school assembly on Monday 4th January 2015 is dedicated to inform the students about Do's and Don't in and out of the school compound.

We seek your cooperation to assist us in maintaining the rules and regulations of the school. Among others, they are :

- Hair tinting, highlighting or colouring
- Wearing any form of jewelry
- Bringing and using mobile phones.
- Dressing sloppily
- Not wearing proper shoes and socks.
- Fighting
- Frequently coming late to school
- Not doing class work or homework
- Having long or coloured nails
- Damaging School property (graffiti on wall/table/chairs etc.)
- Having long and untidy hair.
